



PAEDIATRIC FIRST AID TRAINING

All Royal Naval Preschool Learning Organisation childcare staff must have a full 12 hour Paediatric First Aid qualification and certificate present in their place of work. Failure to do so will result in childcare practitioners being unable to work in any Jack and Jill's childcare facilities.

Paediatric First Aid training will be organised for Jack and Jill's childcare staff . For existing staff their Paediatric First aid course will be booked prior to the expiry date by the Administration Office.

For new Level 2 qualified staff and or Level 3 staff that join the organisation a Paediatric First Aid qualification wherever possible will be booked within three months of starting work in order to be included in the required staff ratios at Level 2 or Level 3 within the setting.

The certificate must be a full course and must be renewed every three years and be relevant for people caring for young children and babies.

If a staff member does not attend the **Full 12 hour** First Aid training booked resulting in their qualification becoming invalid, they will then be responsible for booking themselves on an appropriate training course and meeting the costs and be unable to work until the certificate has been produced within the setting.
